Dennis was born and raised in Albia, Iowa. He is a former investigator with the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners and served as an Associate Director where he headed up the Enforcement Section. He served 10 years as a member of the Board of Directors for the Iowa Sheriff' and Deputies Association including two years as President.
